Two members of the Order of Malta, Dr. Don Barnhorst, KM, Federal Association, and Tom Egan, KM, American Association, Northeast Florida, joined a Medical Mission team that served in the Dominican Republic from January 17 through January 21, 2019. These doctors, nurses, medical students, and volunteers diagnosed, treated, medicated and charted 600 patients in three days in some of the poorest communities in the Dominican Republic, and provided dental treatment to another 600. This team originates from Our Lady Star of the Sea Parish in Ponte Vedra, Florida, in the Jacksonville Area.
