Frà Nicola was delegated by the Grand Master to receive the Promise of Obedience of the three new members of the Second Class.

In a separate ceremony, Mr. Robert Fitzgerald made his Promise at a Mass on November 4th at the Curé of Ars Church in Leawood, Kansas. Frà Tom Mulligan was delegated by the Grand Master to receive Mr. Fitzgerald's Promise.

Each of these new Knights in Obedience made the Promise under the rules of the new Constitution. The Promises are made for a period of three years, after which the Knight or Dame making the Promise may (with approval) either make a final Promise of Obedience or make another 3-year temporary Promise. Nevertheless, having made the first Promise, the member is considered a member in Obedience with all the rights and privileges associated with the Second Class.

Subpriory Welcomes Two New Chaplains

The Subpriory added two new Associate Chaplains who will primarily help in the area of formation of other chaplains and formation of members for admission to the Second Class of our Order. They are the Reverend Monsignor Douglas Mathers, ChM, and Father Richard Mullins, ChC. They will work closely with the other Chaplains of the Subpriory, namely the Reverend Monsignor James Watkins, ChC, Chief Chaplain; the Reverend Father Joseph Cavoto, OFM, Assistant Chief Chaplain; and the Reverend Father Timothy Brown, SJ, Associate Chaplain.

A series of Zoom talks on spirituality for Subpriory members in the First and Second Class was initiated this Fall. Our Principal Chaplain, Monsignor Watkins delivered the first talk on October 25th and the topic was "The Eucharist: Let us give thanks to the Lord."
