


From the Chair:

THE INSIGNIA OF THE ORDER SYMBOLIZES THE CHARACTER OF THE KNIGHTS AND DAMES, AND THE WORK THEY PERFORM ON BEHALF OF THE ORDER.

THE SHIELD with a white cross on a red background from which the insignia hangs represents the ensign of the Order.

TWIRLED RIBBON represents fidelity.

SMALL CROSS just above the crown — the wooden cross upon which Christ died.

THE CROWN directly below the cross — the sovereignty of the Order. **THE MALTESE CROSS** hanging below the crown — the badge of the Order.

THE FOUR ARMS OF THE CROSS — the virtues of temperance, prudence, justice and fortitude.

THE WHITE IN THE ARMS OF THE CROSS — purity of deed.

THE EIGHT POINTS OF THE CROSS — the eight Beatitudes as proclaimed by Christ in his Sermon on the Mount

News from the Prison Ministry A Work of Malta's American Association

The American Association Prison Ministry is supporting all the diocese in the State of Florida. Several Malta's are actively engaged in visiting jails and prisons to bring consolation and the the gospel to the incarcerated.

The Malta Bible and Prayer Book Program is dispensing books from Key West throughout the state. Steve Caron K.M., editor of The Saving Brother, a quarterly Malta prison newsletter, sends three-thousand copies to locations

throughout the state, at the request to the participating Malta's. These newsletters are seen by a total of approximately five inmates per copy, giving it exposure approximately 15,000 inmates. Malta is also a signatory to the Coalition for Smart Justice here in Florida. Last year the Coalition supported several pieces of legislation that passed the legislature and were signed into law, to help improve several issues
