### Defense of the Faith Symposium

Our annual Defense of the Faith Symposium will be held on Sunday, March 18, 2018, at 4:00PM at St. John Neumann Catholic High School, 3000 53rd St SW, Naples. Our speaker will be Bishop Frank Dewane, Bishop of the Diocese of Venice. He will be speaking on issues of faith in today's church. The symposium is open to the public, so please bring friends. A question and answer session and reception will follow the presentation.

### February Mini-Retreat

Our mini-retreat on February 2 was very well attended, with over 70 members and guests. The day started with Mass celebrated by our retreat master, Father Ian Jeremiah from Greenwich, Connecticut and Father George Ratzmann, our chaplain. After Mass, Father Jeremiah gave an inspiring conference focused on the pursuit of joy, rather than happiness, through a Christ centered life. He gave us a number of pithy questions to ask ourselves on a regular basis. They included, "If I find myself farther from God, who moved?" and, "For whom am I working". He also suggested a prayer to help us focus: "Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, have mercy on me, a sinner". We currently have sufficient funds to provide 30 backpacks to those who escape from human trafficking.
