

PRAYER OVER THE OIL

Celebrant: Brothers and Sisters, as we give thanks to God for the gift of sacramental grace symbolized by the use of this holy oil, I invite you to respond to each of these three prayers of praise by saying "Blessed be God who heals us in Christ."

Celebrant: Praise to you, God, the almighty Father. You sent your Son to live among us and bring us salvation.

All: Blessed be God who heals us in Christ.

Celebrant: Praise to you, God, the only-begotten Son.You humbled yourself to share in our humanity and you heal our infirmities.

All: Blessed be God who heals us in Christ.

Celebrant: Praise to you God, the Holy Spirit, the Consoler.Your unfailing power gives us strength in our bodily weakness.

All: Blessed be God who heals us in Christ.

Celebrant: God of mercy, ease the sufferings and comfort the weakness of your servants whom the Church anoints with holy oil.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

Anointing

The priest anoints the forehead:

Through this holy anointing, nay the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit.

R. Amen.

The priest then anoints the hands:

May the Lord who frees you from sin Save you and raise you up.

R. Amen.
