The American Association's Pen Pal Program is a popular way to become involved in our ministry. Knights, Dames, Auxiliary and Volunteers have joined the Program, which consists of (1) letting us know you would like to become a pen pal, (2) being given an inmate's name to whom you would write, (3) being furnished "guidelines" and general pen pal information and (4) writing to your pen pal once a month.

- Since 2018, we have had over 1.1 K insiders participate; 320 have been released, 49 have discontinued for various reasons. Currently 682 insiders participate.
- Currently there are 652 outside pen pals; with 30 withdrawing through the history of the program
- The current number of Order of Malta Pen Pals are 53

TRANSFORMATION

Revolutionizing Distribution in 2025

Thanks to a partnership with Christianbook, LLC, we're transitioning from a manual, volunteer-led model to a professionalized monthly order and distribution system.

All Bibles will now feature a larger 11-point for improved readability.

Digital Expansion

This encompasses our costs for producing/acquiring materials for distribution on prison tablets in collaboration with Catholic Distance University (CDU). CDU is the oldest and largest On-line Catholic University. They have established an alliance with Edovo, a tablet provider to 500 US prisons whose platform distributes digital content. We have access to this channel through cooperative development of content via Malta's Federal Association.

⇐ Dismas Home Expansion (NH)

Dismas Home, New Hampshire serves post-incarcerated women released from the NH Correctional System. Seven years ago, Malta (Boston Area) donated a van which has become a necessary tool and program staple. In 2024, Malta AA Prison Ministry supported the repair and maintenance costs of the van. Dismas Home is opening a new home in Rochester, NH which will house 20 women. Together, with the original home in Manchester, the NH Dismas Homes will house 28 women. In 2025, the AA of M Prison Ministry is supporting the construction of a secure medicine room for the new DH facility in Rochester. This is required by NH State law.
